Reflection: 'Love our enemies, do good to those who hate us, bless those who curse us, pray for those who mistreat us. If anyone strikes you on the cheek, offer the other!' Listening to the news constantly reporting on wars, stabbing, shootings.... This feels like a lot to ask! Bishop Tutu served as a leader in South Africa during the struggle to dismantle apartheid, and he certainly gathered a lot of enemies. He is an example of how we can live our lives in the way that Jesus is asking us today. Bishop Tutu never became bitter or hateful. He never deviated from what the Bible taught him – to love and forgive his enemies. He managed to go through his entire life with this focus. In an interview he was asked his secret to doing this. How was he able to live by these challenging teachings of Jesus? Bishop Tutu's answer was both complicated and simple.

"I hold on, and often only by the skin of my teeth, to believe that God is in charge of his world, in spite of all appearances to the contrary. Forgiving, is not forgetting; it's actually remembering – remembering and not using your right to hit back. It's a second chance for a new beginning." (Bishop Tutu's Hopes and Fears)
